Accepted Items

Please ensure items are clean and in good condition before donating

- Pants for Girls (4T-16) and Boys (sizes 4 to 20)
- Shirts for Girls and Boys (sizes XS-XL)
- Adult size clothes that would be worn by teens and pre-teens.
 - Pants for Young Women (sizes 0 to 26)
 - Pants for Young Men (waist sizes 28 to 46)
 - Shirts for Young Women (sizes XS-3XL) and Young Men (sizes XS-5XL)
- New underwear and socks**
- Shoes that are in good condition and suitable for school (starting at kids size 8) Coats and jackets in good condition and suitable for school (all sizes)
- Belts, purses, hats, jewelry, backpacks, winter accessories, bras, toys and books.

**These must be in unopened packages. Sorry, we do <u>not</u> accept used underwear or socks.

Greatest Needs

- Pants for Girls and Boys (sizes 5T-20)
- Warm winter coats for anyone (especially for Young Men and larger sizes for Boys and Girls)
- NEW, packaged underwear for anyone (kids size 6 to adult)
- NEW, packaged socks for anyone (kids size small to adult)
- Shoes for anyone (especially kids sizes 11-5 tennis shoes are very popular)
- Plus-size jeans and pants for Young Women (sizes 12 and up)
- Pants for Young Men (especially waist size 27-38)
- Clothing appropriate for school uniforms for anyone (khaki, black or navy pants and polo shirts)

About Clothes To Kids Rhode Island, Inc.

Clothes To Kids Rhode Island (CTKRI) is a 501c3 non-profit that provides new and quality used clothing to school-age students from low-income or in-crisis families in the Providence Metro Area, free of charge.

Founded in 2016, CTKRI provides wardrobes to children in Kindergarten through 12th grade. Families are referred to CTKRI by a social service agency, school or place of worship or they use their Free & Reduced lunch letter as the referral. Children can shop twice a year to get a weeks' worth of clothing consisting of: 5 tops, 4 bottoms (pants, shorts or skirts), 1 dress (optional), 5 pair of new socks, 5 pairs new underwear, 1 pair shoes and 1 coat.

CTKRI works hard to minimize overhead costs and ensure our donors' dollars go where they matter most – to the children we serve.
