## Undie 500 Guidelines

- Underwear or socks collected must be NEW and in packages to count for your team. Used items are not accepted. The suggested collection goal is 500 pairs per team.
- Underwear and socks should be children's size 6 (small) and larger. CTKRI accepts adult sizes.
- The timing for Undie 500 drives is very flexible so that you can pick a time of year that is right for your group. We suggest scheduling your collection for a two-week period.
- Final numbers for all of the teams will be announced at the end of he year, so please plan to have all donations turned in to CTKRI by December 16, 2016.
